IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The BLM outlined parking requirements will be in effect again this year for the staging and surrounding areas. As you enter the area (crossing the cattle guard near the pits), please be aware of the signage and instructions.
 - There is to be NO PARKING / CAMPING on the south (right) side of the road. Camping on the north (left) side of the road is limited on the West edge to the flat area just after the last water bar that crosses the road leading into the pits. We will have signage that states, "Camping OK from here to the Pits".
 - Like last year, there will be no camping on the Hill side of pit row. All camping/parking on the East side of pit row MUST BE PERPENDICULAR to pit row and no closer than 30 feet. Look for stakes and ribbon.
 - There is to be NO Parking / Camping across the wash south of the staging area.
 - In the northern half of the actual staging area, please try to park in an orderly fashion to allow for the maximum possible vehicles in this area. Please get cozy with your neighbor.
- The BLM is mandating that any fuel cans sitting on the ground must be placed on fuel absorbent material. Additionally, fuel absorbent material must be under each pitting bike / quad if the pit stop involves fueling. If you have access to this material, please try to bring your own (30" x 30" minimum). Remember, each pit area must have a fire extinguisher next to any fuel tank(s).
- Unless rain comes soon, it appears we will be **UNDER EXTREME FIRE DANGER REGULATIONS**. We have dealt with these requirements at previous events. We will follow the rules EXACTLY AS OUTLINED by the BLM/USFS for the particular fire stage we may be in at the time. This has unfortunately become the norm for this race over the last few years and all of you have done an excellent job in this area in the past.
 - Likely there will be no open flames (campfires) allowed in the area, including no smoking outside of vehicles.
 - ABSOLUTELY no fireworks allowed.
 - Contained fuel BBQ grills may be allowed but watch for further communication..
 - Remember SPARK ARRESTORS ARE MANDATORY and WILL BE CHECKED. NO EXCEPTIONS - COME PREPARED
- BLM wants to remind you that there may be BLM and/or Game & Fish Law Enforcement Officers at the event and they will be enforcing all the NM OHV laws and regulations (Spark arrestors, registration, youth rules, etc). Specifically, they remind you to stay on existing roads and trails at all times and limit your speed in and around the congested areas to 20MPH or less (NMDRC rule, bikes, quads and pit rides, 1st gear only). 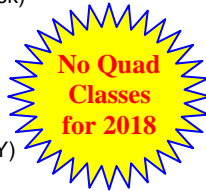

MANDATORY TECH -CHECK LIST

- ✓ Spark Arrestors - US Forest approved & no exhaust leaks.
- ✓ Tight nuts & bolts - Keep it safe!
- ✓ Water system (CamelBak, etc) required to race.
- ✓ Fire extinguishers - Required In all pits next to gas cans.
- ✓ Riding gear - Helmet with no cracks, eye protection, long sleeves, boots over the ankle (no sneakers).
- ✓ Race card - On helmet clear of goggle strap (attach with electrical tape).
- ✓ Numbers - Permanent number on all three number plates..

ABOUT THE RACE

This will be a timed event. The course will be hills, ridges, sand washes and roads. The elevation is between 6500' & 7500'. The loops will be approximately 21 miles long. The number of loops to be run are as follows:

EXPERTS	4 LOOPS
AMATEUR	3 LOOPS
ALL OTHERS	2 LOOPS
IRONMAN	1 LOOP

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Gas It NUMBERS WILL BE USED. If you raced in any of the '18 Gas It races, the number assigned to you will be your number for this event. If you have not raced yet this year and do not have a current number, log onto www.gasitoffroad.com and follow the instructions to choose a number. SPARK ARRESTORS ARE MANDATORY! BLM will be on hand to check for spark arrestors, registration and to enforce all NM OHV Laws. BE PREPARED! Liability insurance will be provided for the spectators. There is no medical insurance for the riders.

PIT AREA

SAFETY FIRST!! You must pit at least 20' from the racing surface or 50' outside corners. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS are required in all pit areas. Camping will be available in the pit area only. Racers will be responsible for their camp / pit area. PLEASE KEEP IT CLEAN! Please watch for our mini racers.

DIRECTIONS

From Espanola, proceed north on Hwy 68 toward Taos. Just past mile marker 8, on the East side of the Hwy, there will be a cattle guard entrance to the BLM area. From there follow the course markers to the pit area approx 2 miles to the East.

GPS Coordinates: 36° 5'13.67"N / 106° 0'30.24"W

SPECIAL RULES

- No gassing of your bike with the engine running. Time penalty for violators.
- Overnight camping 10 pm curfew (Includes generators).
- If you break down on the course and leave the course to return to pits, you are out of the race. You can get help from the check points. DO NOT GO BACKWARDS on or alongside the course to the pits. You must go forward on the course at all times (this includes sweep riders)..
- Protests must be filled out within 30 minutes of the close of the race. All protests must be submitted in writing with a \$25 protest fee.
- You must clean up your pits and put out your campfires or be subject to time and point penalties.

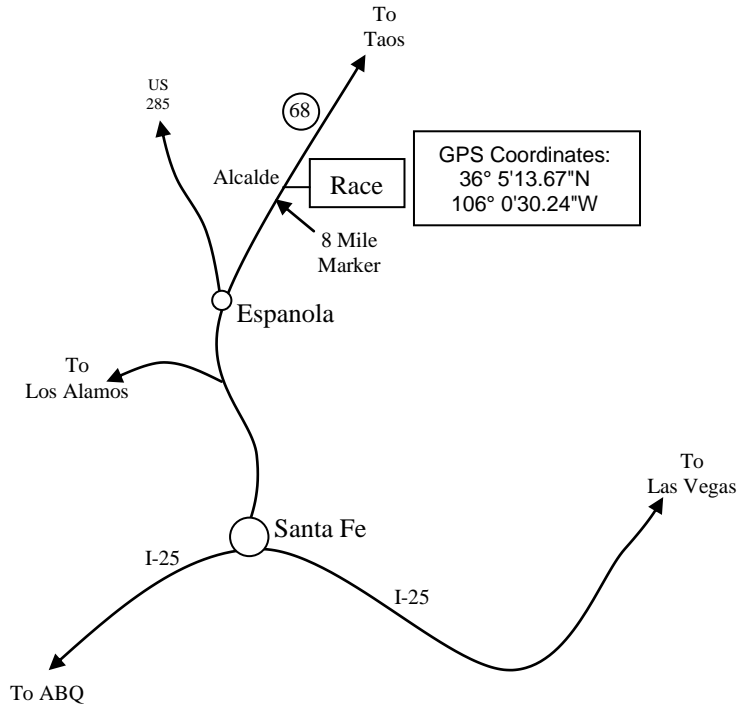
